| Ö | Wrap fragile items with towels, t-shirts, or pillowcases Pack spices inside small appliances (like slow cookers!) Use laundry baskets, bins, and suitcases to avoid buying extra boxes | |
| LABEL BOXES LIKE A PRO | | |
| Ö | Write on the sides of boxes and the top! Include room + contents clearly Use "Fragile" or "Open First" stickers where needed | |
| COLOR-CODED TAPE SYSTEM (Highly Recommended!) | | |
| | Assign a color to each room (ex: Blue = Bedroom, Yellow = Kitchen) Mark each box AND each room door with matching tape Post a color key at the entrance for quick reference Result: zero box confusion, happy movers, smooth unpacking! | |
| PACK SMART BY CATEGORY | | |
| | Like items together (no junk boxes!) Small boxes = heavy items (books, tools) Large boxes = light items (pillows, linens) Fill empty spaces with soft materials to prevent shifting | |
